

ORDINANCE NO. 1002

Passed July 6, 1949

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PUBLIC PEACE
The Village of Estral Beach ordains:

Section 1. Any person who shall use indecent and immoral language or who shall be guilty of indecent or immoral practices or conduct or behavior within the Village shall be punished as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. Any person who shall designedly make any indecent exposure of his or her persons in the streets, lanes, alleys, public places, or elsewhere in said Village shall be punished as hereafter provided.

Section 3. Any person who shall show, sell or offer for sale or exhibit any indecent obscene pictures, drawings, engravings, books or literature shall be punished as hereinafter provided.

Section 4. Any person or persons who shall make or assist in making any great or unnecessary noises, disturbance or improper diversions, or any rout, or riot, or shall be guilty of disorderly conduct shall be punished as hereinafter provided.

Section 5. All persons who shall be found within this Village in a state of intoxication shall be punished as hereinafter provided.

Section 6. Any person who shall violate any provisions of this Ordinance, upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars and cost of prosecution or imprisonment in the County jail not to exceed ninety days, or both in the discretion of the court.

Section 7. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect in twenty days from and after the passage thereof.
