

ORDINANCE NO. 1028

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF VESSELS  
ON WATERS OF THE VILLAGE OF ESTRAL BEACH, MICH-  
IGAN

The Village of Estral Beach Ordains:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS:

All words and phrases used in this ordinance shall be as construed and defined un Act 303, Public Acts of 1967, and known as the Marine Safety Act.

SECTION 2. SWAN CREEK AND CANALS; SLOW - NO WAKE BPEED.

On the waters of Swan Creek and all natural and artificial canals and channels in the Village of Estral Beach, Monroe County, it shall be unlawful for the operator of a vessel to exceed a slow-no wake speed.

SECTION 3. AUTHORITY:

This ordinance is enacted under the authority of Act 303, Public Acts of 1967 (M.S.A. 18.1287 (17)), being identical to a State Administrative Rule duly promulgated by the Natural resources Commission and filed in the offices of the Secretary of State, Lansing, Michigan.

SECTION 4. REPEALER:

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. PENALTY:

Violations of this ordinance are a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) together with costs of prosecution or imprisonment in the county jail or such other place of detention as the court may prescribe, for a period not to exceed ninety days (90), or said fine, costs of prosecutions and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 6.

This ordinance shall be published within ten (10) days of passage thereof and shall become operative and in full force and effect upon said publication.
