ORDINANCE NO. 1003

Passed July 6, 1949

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT HUNTING IN THE LIMITS OF VILLAGE OF ESTRAL BEACH WITHOUT A PERMIT: AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF:

The Village of Estral Beach ordains:

Section 1. It is unlawful for any person to hunt within the Village limits without a permit from the Commissioners of Estral Beach.

Section 2. It shall be lawful for a person to hunt without a permit upon his own property.

Section 3. Any person violating any provisions of this Ordinance upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars and cost of prosecution or imprisonment in the County Jail not to exceed ninety days or both in the discretion of the court. Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force twenty days from and after passage.
