AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF OCCUPIED AND UNOCCUPIED CAMP AND OR HOUSE TRAILERS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF ESTRAL BEACH: TO REQUIRE THE REGISTRATION OF OCCUPANTS OF CAMP AND/OR HOUSE TRAILERS; AND TO FIX PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Village of Estral Beach Ordains:

Camp and/or House Trailer:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of this Ordinance, a camp and/or House Trailer is hereby defined and declared to be any vehicle used, or intended for use, as a conveyance upon the public streets highways and duly licensed as such; and shall include self-propedded and non-self-propelled vehicles so designed, constructed, reconstructed, or added to by means of portable accessories in such manner as will permit the occupancy thereof as a temporary dwelling or sleeping place for one or more persons, and having no foudation other than wheels, jacks or skirtings so arranged as to be integral with or portable by sail Camp and/or Trailer.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful within the limits of the village of Estral Beach for any person, firm or corporation to park overnight, or permit the parking overnight, of any Camp and/or House Trailer on any public highway, street, alley, park of other public space. No occupied Camp and/or House Trailer shall be parked on any site, lot, field, or tract of land within the Village of Estral Beach not specifically licensed for the purpose; except that, nothing herein contained shall prohibit the parking, without charge therefor, of not more than one occupied Camp and/or House Trailer on the Premises of any occupied dwelling, provided that the operator of such Camp and/or House Trailer, within one week after his arrival, shall make application to the Chief of Police of the Village of Estral Beach, or is to be Parked, for a permit, which permit, if granted, shall limit the time for such parking to a period not longer than six weeks from the date of application therefor. No more than one such permit shall be issued to any one occupied Camp and/or House Trailer owner. operator, or occupant, in any one twelve months' period. Application for permit shall contain a statement showing the street number of the occupied dwelling where the occupied Camp and/or House Trailer is parked, or is to be parked; the name of the occupant in control of said dwelling, and his endorsement granting permission for such parking; the name and address of the occupants of such Camp and House Trailer;

the license numbers of all units of such Camp and/or House Trailer; the State issuing such license; and a statement indication the exact location at which such Camp and/or House Trailer last parked, including the state, city, town or village where such parking occurred. A copy of such permit shall be posted in or on the Camp and/or House Trailer for which it was issued in such a manner as to be readily noticeable at all times.

SECTION 3. All excreta and liquid waste shall be collected in proper receptacled and emptied into suitable sewer connected fixtures. Spilling or draining of any waste water what so ever upon the groundor upon paved areas is prohibited.

SECTION 4. No owner or operator of any Camp and/or House Trailer shall remove the wheels of tires, cause the same to be removed, from any such occupied vehicle parked within the limits of the Village of Estral Beach except for the purpose of repair; nor in any manner elevate, block or stabilize said vehicle other than with jacks designed, provided and intended for that purpose.

SECTION 5. No Camp and/or House Trailer, parked within the limits of the Village of Estral Beach, shall at any time be so occupied for sleeping purpose as to over crowd said vehicle to exceed the number of persons for which it is designed and arranged.

SECTION 6. Any person, or any owner, operator or occupant of a Camp and/or House Trailer violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeaner and upon conviction thereof, subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00 or to imprionment in the Monroe City Jail for a period of not more than 90 days, or to both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force twenty (20) days from and after passage.
